Activity 1 – J'aime

Introductory Song

Watch this song and practice saying "J'aime..." which means I like or I love. You pronounce it "Dgem"

This song is all about different fruits. Some fruits sound similar in French and in English. Some are completely different. Play the song again and see if you can find the French word for

Pineapple (I LOVE THIS WORD!),

Apple

Cherry

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Pear

You can look at the pictures in the song to help you.

Can you write me three sentences saying which fruits you like.....Read my sentences first and see which fruit I like. You can choose your favourite fruit from the song and pause it to listen to how you say it and see how you spell it.

J'aime les cerises.

J'aime les pommes.

J'aime les poires.

Activity 2 – Je n'aime pas

How to say I don't like.....Younger children can watch the following video about a tortoise called Tonton who is hungry. He keeps saying "J'ai faim..." it sounds like "Jay fam" and it means "I am hungry". Watch what happens when he eats the soup. Does he like it or not? Practice saying what he says.... What does he say when he eat the chicken (le Poulet which sounds like le poolay).
