

Sports Premium Funding

What is the Sport Premium?

In April 2013 the Government announced new funding of 150 million for Physical Education (PE) and Sport often referred to as a Sport Premium. This funding is to be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and Sport provision.

Current Provision

We are proud of the current PE curriculum provision at our school and of the wealth of extra-curricular opportunities that we provide for our pupils. Afterschool sports clubs include; Tae Kwondo, Football (Y1-Y6), netball, cricket, dodgeball.

We also run a Junior Play Leader program for our Year 5/6 pupils support sports activities at lunchtime.

All classes (Y1-6) have taken part in inter school sports activities such as cross country, Tag Rugby festival, KS1 Multiskills, Dance festival, Athletics festivals as well as our yearly annual FS, KS1 and KS2 Sports Days.

In addition to this, our school sports teams take part in leagues run by the London PE and School Sports Network in football (boys and girls separately), netball and cricket.

Our Football A team (mixed) plays in the Lambeth and Southwark Primary Football League on Saturdays.

Sports Premium (2017-18 Academic Year)

Each school will be given a standard sum of £16,000 and then £10 per child on roll.
