Each week, we will set you:

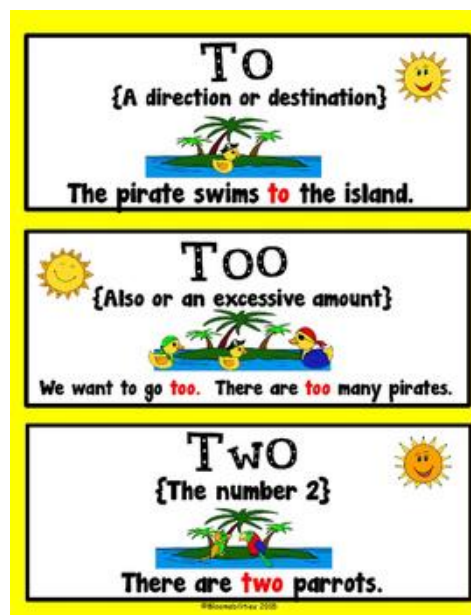
- a task which focuses on a specific spelling or grammar rule – this week is the homophones two, too and to.

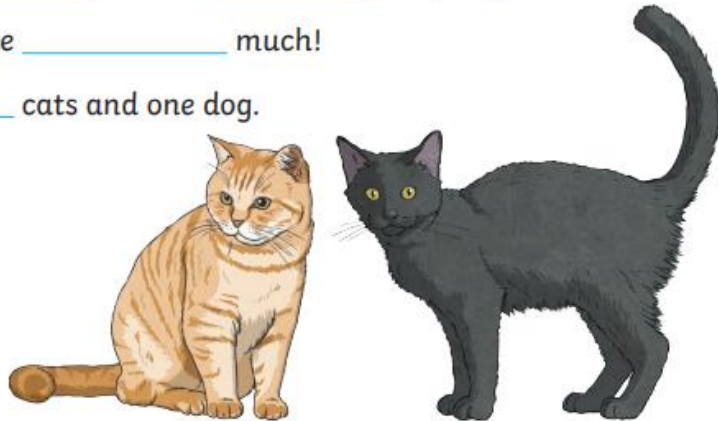
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Here are some examples of these homophones in sentences:
