Year 2 Curriculum Map Autumn 1, 2022

This term's value is: **Community** In our learning we will be exploring the 'big idea' of: **Democracy - rules and community**

Key Information

Maths:

<u>Place value</u>- recognising the place value of <u>2</u> <u>digit</u> numbers, partitioning 2 digit numbers and ordering numbers within 100.

<u>Addition and subtraction</u>-recall number bonds to 10 and 20, add and subtract <u>1 digit</u> numbers to/from 2 digit numbers, solve one step problems.



<u>Help at home:</u> We will often use 'Hit the Button' online to help the children to quickly recall number bonds and multiplication facts. This is a great tool to use at home as well.

Mathletics

English: 'Jim & The Beanstalk' and 'Goldilocks and Just One Bear'



In English this half term Jim and Goldilocks will need our assistance! We will be helping them to twist traditional tales into new and exciting stories for

children to read. <u>Help at home</u>: When writing stories it is really important that the children think about word choice and using interesting adjectives, verbs and adverbs. Make a list of wow words and bring in any new words to share with the class.

Our learning journey

We will start the year by learning about God's 10 commandments in Christianity. We will be exploring the importance of rules in other aspects of life, particularly our own classroom rules. Once we have a good understanding of why we have rules, we will consider when it might be appropriate to break the rules, looking at the character of Goldilocks as well as famous rule breakers like Rosa Parks. Throughout our learning, we will be coming back to the 'big idea' of democracy by exploring how rules impact ourselves and our communities.

DT: This year we plan on creating our own vibrant planter using recycled materials. Once completed, we will be able to grow a number of plants over the course of the year.

PSHE: Our PSHE learning this half term is about 'Being Me in My World.' We will think about how our actions can impact our class and our school.

<u>Help at home</u>: Discuss the positive impacts that helpful choices can make.

Science: In science, we will be focussing on plants. We will be learning about what plants need to grow and stay healthy. <u>Help at home:</u> Grow a bean and keep a record of its growth.

RE

We will be learning about God's commandments before researching our school saints, St John and St Clement. <u>Help at home</u>: Discuss the importance of the 10 commandments.

Geography

To build on our understanding of our community we are learning all about maps. <u>Help at home</u>: Can you spot different human (man-made) and physical (naturally occurring) features outside of your home?

Art

During our art lessons, we will be exploring the work and times of our class artist, and creating artwork inspired by them. We will also be working on large scale and collaborative exhibition pieces for our upcoming SJSC Arts Festival.

Help at home- these are ideas you can do with your child at home. It would be fantastic for children to bring any home learning into school to share with the class. These are optional. Home learning will be sent separately.

Please sign and keep a note in your reading records of the book your child is reading, how much your child is reading independently and how many pages per night. Reading records to be returned upon completion of a book and a new book will be issued.

By the end of year 2 children should know their 2/5/10 times table. We would therefore strongly encourage you child to practice Times Table Rockstars and complete their Mathletics which is set every week on a Friday afternoon.

Year 2 spellings are handed out on Friday for a spelling check the following Friday. These words will be based on common exception words, tricky spellings and words that have been used in our literacy sessions.
